

Chemical Management Policy

At Global Furniture Group, we aim to manufacture high-quality products made with chemicals and materials that are not harmful to our employees, customers, or the environment. To support this goal, we are working with our suppliers to trace and assess the make-up of every material used in our products down to 100 parts per million. Using this data, we minimize chemicals of concern across the product life-cycle, and work to replace them with effective, safe alternatives. This policy applies to products that are procured from our supply chain, used in our manufacturing processes, and otherwise found in our production facilities.

Global requires that suppliers disclose full chemical ingredient information prior to purchase of their products. No new chemical-containing product shall be purchased or brought onto the premises without first undergoing evaluation by the Environment Department, as per chemical acceptance guidelines. Suppliers that demonstrate cooperation with this policy, and incorporate green chemistry into their product composition, will be preferred.

Employees are required to adhere to all elements set out in the Chemical Management Plan, which focuses on prevention and mitigation of hazards. This includes proper storage, labelling, handling, transport, and disposal of chemicals. Employees must not bring new chemicals on to the premises, or transfer chemicals between buildings, without permission from the Environment department.

Through the careful evaluation, selection, and tracking of chemicals, we are able to provide transparency for our stakeholders by providing accurate and meaningful product composition information. This enables our customers to meet their own personal chemical requirements, and select products that best meet the needs of their users. This is part of our larger goal to ensure our products contribute to healthier workplaces for everyone.
